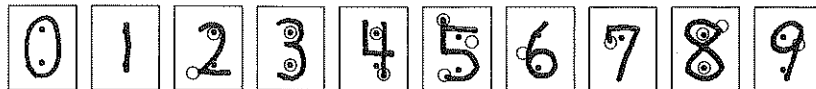

After rain, we sometimes see *rainbows. They are *colorful and beautiful. We are (ア) to see them. Did you draw a picture of rainbows when you were a small child? If so, how many colors did you use then? Many Japanese people may say seven: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, light blue, and purple. But if you ask the same question to people in other countries, some people will say six and other people say five. Rainbows are the same *wherever we live. Then, why are their answers different?

One of the reasons is the *sense of color is different among different cultures. People in some countries are *sensitive to colors and try to *distinguish many colors, but people in other countries are not. Actually, there are *countless *neutral colors. It's hard to *count colors between two colors like green and blue or red and orange. So, no one can say (ウ). The *differences in sense of color are also seen in the color of the sun.

For example, Japanese people usually choose red to draw the sun. But many people living in other countries use yellow. Actually, the sun is not red. Then why do we draw the sun in that way? *Long ago Japanese people chose to use a red color for the sun for some reasons. And that idea was *passed down to their children. It's a part of culture. In this way, each culture has its own way of using colors.

Do you understand that it's not a problem how many colors people see in rainbows? We can't say to anyone, "We're right and you're wrong." Everyone needs to (エ) other's *views and enjoy the differences among us.

In Hawaii, there is a *saying, "No Rain, No Rainbow." That means, "It's not possible to have happy things *unless something sad happens first." If you see a rainbow when you have a serious problem, remember that. It'll make you feel better. After a while, something good will happen to you.
